Cross Connection Control Policy Statement for Deschutes Mobile Park

Pursuant to Chapter 333, Division 61 of the Oregon Administrative Rules, it is the responsibility of Deschutes Mobile Park to protect its drinking water by implementing a cross connection control program. Therefore, Deschutes Mobile Park adopts this cross connection control policy statement.

- 1. The purpose of this policy statement is to protect the water supply of Deschutes Mobile Park from contamination or pollution due to any existing or potential cross connections.
- 2. No cross connections shall be created, installed, or maintained within the territory served by Deschutes Mobile Park.
- 3. All cross connection control practices and procedures used by Deschutes Mobile Park will be in compliance with Oregon Administrative Rule parts 333-61-070 Cross Connection Control Requirements; 333-61-071 Backflow Device Installation Standards; and 333-61-072 Cross Connection Tester and Inspector Certification; and the Uniform Plumbing Code Chapter 10.
- 4. It is the responsibility of all property owners and their renters to abide by the conditions of this policy statement.
- 5. Failure on the part of any customer to comply with this cross connection control policy statement will result in the termination of water service to that customer until compliance has been achieved, pursuant to Chapter 333, OAR.

6. This policy statement shall be effective as of June 1, 1995.
