TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN;

THE WATER SYSTEM FOR OUR PARK REALLY HAS ONLY ONE HAZARD, A MINOR ONE AT THAT: THE OUTLET FAUCETS THAT THE TENANTS USE FOR GARDENING, WASHING THEIR MOBILES AND OTHER VEHICLES, AND POSSIBLY FILLING OUTDOOR KIDS POOLS IN THE SUMMER ARE DIRECTLY CONNECTED TO THE POTABLE WATER SUPPLY FOR THE WHOLE PARK.

AS A PRELIMINARY PRECAUTION WE DID ISSUE A WRITTEN WATER SAFETY POLICY TO OUR TENANTS ACOUPLE OF YEARS AGO. ATTACHED FIND A COPY.

AFTER MUCH DELIBERATION WE HAVE DECIDED THAT THE MOST COST-FEASIBLE WAY FOR US TO ELIMINATE THE HAZARD IS TO FURNISH A SEPARATE WATER SUPPLY FOR THE PURPOSES OUTLINED ABOVE. THIS SEPARATE WATER SUPPLY WOULD BE NON-POTABLE WATER FROM THE GOLD HILL IRRIGATION DITCH. EACH FAUCET CONTAINING NON-POTABLE WATER WILL BE CLEARLY MARKED AS SUCH AND WE ARE TRYING TO OBTAIN CHILD -PROOF FAUCETS FOR SAFETY'S SAKE.

AFTER WE FINISH INSTALLING THE SEPARATE SYSTEM, OUR WRITTEN POLICY WILL BE UP DATED TO READ THAT WE PROHIBIT ANY USE OF THE POTABLE WATER SYSTEM FOR ANY PURPOSE OTHER THAN IN THE MOBILES OWN WATER SYSTEM, AND THAT NO OTHER OUTLETS ARE TO BE INSTALLED FROM THE POTABLE WATER SYSTEM IN THE MOBILE.

WE ARE CONSIDERING INSTALLING A REDUCED PRESSURE VALUE AT A POSSIBLE CROSS-CONNECTION BETWEEN THE NON-POTABLE WATER SYSTEM AND THE POTABLE WATER SYSTEM SO THAT WE MAY DIRECT THE POTABLE WATER THROUGH THE NON-POTABLE SYSTEM FOR FIRE PURPOSES DURING THE WINTER WHEN THE GOLD HILL IRRIGATION SYSTEM DOES NOT SUPPLY WATER FROM THE RIVER BUT USUALLY THERE IS ENOUGH WATER IN THE DITCH ANYWAY FOR FIRE USE.

WE HAVE BEEN TOLD THAT EVEN THOUGH OUR SYSTEMS LINES MAY BE 1-1/2" TO 2", WE CAN INSTALL AN INCH REDUCED PRESSURE VALUE AT THE CROSS-CONNECTION. IS THIS PERMISSIBLE? AND WOULD THE SAME SORT AO APPLICATION BE PERMISSIBLE AT THE LOCATION WHERE WE ARE INSTALLING THE DOUBLE CHECK VALVE TO PROTECT THE WELL HEAD?

NATURALLY WE ARE HAVING AN AUTHORIZED INSTALLER DO THE WORK AND THE NECESSARY TESTING AND MAINTENANCE AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

WE HOPE THAT THIS LETTER ANSWERS ALL OF THE QUESTION THAT WERE REQUESTED IN THE 1996 ANNUAL SUMMARY REPORT. IF YOU HAVE ANY OTHER QUESTIONS OR SUGGESTIONS, PLEASE DIRECT THEM TO SHARON HINDS OR ERNEST PRITCHETT AT THE ABOVE PHONE NUMBER.

Dear Tenants;

This notice is to notify you of a new water quality control regulation, effective immediately. Please read carefully and if you have any questions, feel free to call us between 9A.M.-5 P.M., Monday through Friday.

In a closed water system, such as ours, a power or water failure or some other event, can cause some consumer products, when used as directed, to affect our water quality.

Consequently we must prohibit the use of any type of chemical/physical mechanism that attaches to any device connected to our water supply. This includes any such device connected to any faucet, tub, shower or toilet within your trailer. Such mechanisms include but are not limited to: such fertilizer sprayers that connect to hoses and devices that are connected to a water supply and are used to flush out radiators. We must also prohibit the habit of leaving a water supply connected hose laying in any container containing chemicals of any kind including soap. An example would be: leaving the end of a hose in a bucket of soapy water while washing your car, trailer, window or other articles.

Failure to comply with these regulations could cause serious illnesses to other tenants and could have severe repercussions for the initiator. If you are in question about any certain practice be on the safe side. <u>DON'T DO IT.</u>
