#10 Water Problem Reporting.

When contacting General Manager concerning water problems, unless it is an extreme emergency, do not call before 8 a.m. and no later than 7 p.m.

The board of directors along with the general manager has the authority to maintain and operate all aspects of the water system. If a problem occurs with the mainline notify the general manager or designated volunteers. Do not attempt to regulate any mainline shutoff valves at any time unless there is an extreme emergency and designated volunteers are unavailable.

#11 Placement of District Truck and Use of Truck

The blue truck and service truck will be kept at a designated location approved by the board, currently at the Paul Jolly residence. The trucks will be used for water district business only and will remain unlocked and accessible-

#12 Cross Connection

It is the policy of the Black Mountain Water District that Cross Connections with any other water sources will not be permitted. A Cross Connection being when either;

1. a water source other than the Black Mountain Water District Springs 1,2,3,4, & 5 or
2. when backflow from a customer owned storage tank is allowed to feed into any potable water system (including from the service valve into the residence) fed by the Black Mountain Water System. Whenever any such cross connection situation is discovered, that customer's service will immediately be shut off and/or disconnected and water service to that customer will be discontinued until the unauthorized cross connection is eliminated. A service fee of \$50.00 will be assessed for shut-off/disconnection and service will not be resumed until removal of the cross connection is verified by a representative of the Black Mountain Water District Board.

#13 Record Retention

Records and reports will be retained only so long as they are necessary to the current conduct of the association's business and required to be retained by State of Oregon Government Regulation OAR Chapter 166 Division 150. Records will be reviewed yearly by two active members of Black Mountain Water District with one to be a board member. A list of the records to be purged will be reviewed and approved by the board.
