Subject: Water System – "Cross Connection Enabling Authority"

To all Ryan's Outpost tenants:

Effective immediately.



Under Oregon law, Ryan's Outpost operates a community water system. The State of Oregon has mandated that we send the following "Cross Connection Enabling Authority" document to all connected water users.

This document will also be incorporated into the "Ryan's Outpost, LLC – Park Rules & Regulations". Therefore, from this point forward, please consider this authority to be part of that document as well.

Cross Connection Enabling Authority

The purpose of this policy is to protect the water supply of Ryan's Outpost, LLC from contamination and pollutants from any cross connections. Also ensure that approved backflow assemblies are tested when put into service and at least on annually thereafter. This policy is in compliance with Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 333-061-0071 and the uniform plumbing code (UPC) as adopted by the state of Oregon.

The installation and maintenance of any unprotected cross connection which would endanger the water supply of Ryan's Outpost, LLC is prohibited. Any such cross connection now existing or hereafter installed is hereby declared unlawful and shall be immediately protected or eliminated.

Criteria for determining the degree of hazard for control or elimination of a cross connection and prescribing appropriate levels of protection, shall be in accordance with the UPC and/or the OAR's.

Water service to any premise is contingent upon the connected user providing appropriate cross connection control if deemed necessary. Determinations and enforcement shall be the responsibility of Ryan's Outpost (Tim Ryan) in conjunction with the Jackson County plumbing inspector. Water service may be refused or terminated to any premise where an unprotected cross connection may allow contamination or pollutants to backflow into the public drinking water system.

Authorized employees of Ryan's Outpost, LLC, with proper identification, shall have free access, at reasonable hours of the day, to all areas of a premise or building to which drinking water is supplied, for the purpose of conducting hazard assessment surveys. Water service

may be refused, terminated, or maximum backflow protection required for any building or premise where access to perform surveys is denied, where unprotected cross connections are located, or in the event that installed assemblies are not tested and maintained as required by the State of Oregon and local regulations.

Before any water service is terminated, a "Due Process" of notifying the connected user and providing a reasonable time for compliance will be observed according to the operating procedures of Ryan's Outpost, LLC. However, in the event of an actual backflow incident which endangers public health, water service may be terminated immediately and not be restored until the cross connection is either eliminated or adequately protected.
