REGULATION CONCERNING CROSS CONNECTION\BACKFLOW

As of December 31, 1995 the State of Oregon, Department of Human Resources Health Division has adopted a Cross Connection\Backflow Control Program.

What this means is you as tenants in Dun-Rollin Mobile Village are to be responsible in maintaining situations for controlling and eliminating a Cross Connection\Backflow hazard to the water supply provided by Dun-Rollin Mobile Village.

A Cross Connection\Backflow occurs when a point in a plumbing system where the potable water supply is connected directly or can be connected directly to a non-potable source. Wherever an unprotected Cross Connection exists, backflow may occur due to either "backsiphonage" or "backpressure".

To prevent a Cross Connection\Backflow from occurring, tenants with such things (example list to follow) that may cause a Cross Connection\Backflow hazard are required to have installed a Cross Connection\Backflow prevention assembly (types, distributors, ~~prices~~ may be obtained from the office). Which ever prevention assembly you chose, first will have to be approved by Dun-Rollin before installing. This may be done by yourself or a certified plumber (certified plumber is recommend).

Cross Connection-Backflow hazards that will require a prevention assembly are:

1. underground sprinkler systems
2. hot tubs
3. swamp cooler type air conditioners

Tenants that have a Cross Connection\Backflow hazard will assume installation costs, prevention assembly costs, and any other costs associated with the installing of this device.

Upon inspection of premises by Dun-Rollin to be believed to have a Cross Connection\Backflow hazard is found and proved to be true, but no prevention assembly as been installed.

Dun-Rollin will turn water off to that premises until which time a prevention assembly is installed.

The installed prevention assembly is to be inspected on a yearly basis by a certified plumber. A copy of this inspection to be provided to Jo Lynne Hackler at the office. These will be due January 1st of each year. Cost of this inspection is the tenants responsibility.
