Sunny Acres Water District Cross Connection policy

In accordance with Oregon State Health Division administration rule 333-61-070, Sunny acres Water District will abide by the required Cross Connection policy taken from "Final Rule" 1/7/94. The following outline are excerpts taken from these administrative rules which would apply specifically to the Sunny acres Water District.

- (1) Water suppliers shall undertake programs for controlling and eliminating cross connections:
 - (a) In Community water systems, water suppliers shall carry out a local cross connection program consisting of the following elements:
 - (A) Local ordinance or enabling authority which authorizes discontinuing water service to premises for failure to install an approved backflow device or conduct a required annual test on a backflow device.

In accordance with the above requirement, Sunny Acres Water District will authorize the discontinuance of water service to premises that do not have an approved backflow device installed, Water service may also be discontinued if there is no record of the required annual test on a backflow device in Sunny Acres's file.

Length of time from date of notice to discontinue water service to the actual termination of service is 30 days from date of notice.

- (B) A written program plan which includes the following:
 - (i) A master list of facilities and premises which are subject to inspection, and the hazard level for each.
 - (ii) A current list of certified inspector staff and work responsibilities.
- (D) The water supplier shall prepare and submit an annual written report to the Division using a format to be provided by the Division.

Sunny Acres Water District's certified inspector as of October of 1996 is Mel Olson, Certification #2410. His work responsibilities include inspections and all follow -up communications.
