

Resolution Enabling Oregon Shores Beach Club Inc.
to Require Backflow Prevention Devices

The purpose of this resolution is to protect the health of people served by the water system maintained by Oregon Shores Beach Club Inc. by preventing contaminants from flowing backwards into the water supply. To accomplish this, the rules in this resolution are in compliance with Oregon Administrative Rules 333-061-0070 through 333-061-0074. The rules include the installation, maintenance and testing of backflow prevention devices and assemblies as well as other rules for the annual reporting of backflow data to the Oregon Health Authority. Oregon Shores Beach Club Inc. mandates compliance with the above stated Oregon Administrative Rules.


RESOLVED: As of this date, actual or potential cross connections are prohibited. If a potential exists for a cross connection, the water system must be protected by an appropriate backflow prevention device or assembly. Most high hazards or health hazards are specified in the above listed Oregon Administrative Rules. The remediation of these hazards will be given the highest priority by Oregon Shores Beach Club Inc.

Oregon Shores Beach Club Inc. has the right to refuse or terminate water service to any customer who does not install a backflow device or assembly when necessary, test it at least annually and repair it if necessary.

Oregon Shores Beach Club Inc. reserves the right to demand a backflow device be installed on the customer's water service line if access is not allowed to determine if a backflow device or assembly is already installed.


Oregon Shores Beach Club Inc. will allow a reasonable time to achieve compliance with this rule, but should a backflow incident occur, Oregon Shores Beach Club Inc. has the right to terminate service immediately and restore it only after compliance.
