

## Casselman's Cove Cross Connection 41-01460

It is unlawful for the owner of property or the user of system water to introduce or permit the introduction of pollution or contamination of any kind into Casselman's Cove water supply system. Whenever cross-connection to other water supply into Casselman' Cove is found, or whenever any other condition is found which presents the possibility of contamination or pollution, the water supply to such premises and or other premises from which cross-connection is made shall be discontinued immediately until the cross-connection is eliminated or the condition remedied. The control or elimination of cross-connection shall be in accordance with any manuals of standard practices pertaining to cross-connection control approved by the system operator, and any requirements set forth by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency as authorized by the Safe Drinking Water Act PL 93-523 and applicable legislation. The system shall require a back-flow prevention device of pattern, design and size which it approved as reasonably adequate to prevent contamination, if the system determines that a complete physical separation from the water system is not necessary, or that adequate inspection for cross-connection device is necessary because of existing or possible backflow resulting from special conditions, use or equipment. The water system shall also regulate the location, installation and testing of such device. Any corrective measure, disconnection or change on private property shall be at the sole expense of the person in control of such property. The cost of any change required in the system outside the property or between the property and the supply line shall be added to the charges for water against the premises necessitating the expenditure.
