ENABLEING AUTHORITY

For

DIAMOND LAKE RESORT

The purpose of this policy is to protect the water supply of Diamond Lake Resort from contamination or pollution from any cross connections, and to assure that approved backflow prevention assemblies are tested when put into service and on a regular basis thereafter. This policy is in compliance with Oregon administrative rule (OAR) 333-061-0071 and the uniform plumbing code (UPC) as adopted by the State of Oregon.

The installation or maintenance of any unprotected cross connection which would endanger the water supply of Diamond Lake Resort is prohibited. Any such cross connection now existing or hereafter installed is hereby declared unlawful and shall be immediately protected or eliminated.

The control or elimination of cross connection and the criteria from determining degrees of hazard and prescribing appropriate levels of protection shall be in accordance with the UPC and or OAR's.

Authorized employees of Diamond Lake Resort shall have free access at reasonable hours of the day, to all areas of a premise or building to which drinking water is supplied for the purpose of conducting hazard assessment surveys. Water service may be refused or terminated, or maximum backflow protection may be required, to the premise where access to perform surveys is denied, where unprotected cross connections are located.

Before any water service is terminated, a "due process" of notification and providing a reasonable time for compliance to be achieved. However, in the event of an actual backflow event which endangers the public health, water service may be terminated immediately until cross connection is either eliminated or adequately protected.
