To All River Haven Tenants,

April 24, 1996

We recently completed our state required backflow inspection. The reason for backflow control is to prevent unwanted liquids from siphoning into our water system. The inspector made some requirements for all tenants. All tenants must either (1) disconnect hoses when not in use, (2) Roll up hoses up off the ground when not in use, or (3) install a backflow valve on your hose bib and connect your hose to the valve. If you do either step (1) or (2) above you are not required to buy a backflow valve. If you have a drip irrigation system at your space, you are required to install a backflow valve at the nearest point of connection to your main hose bib.

State law allows the mobile home park to evict tenants that do not comply with this new requirement.
