### Enabling Ordinance

According to ORS 333-61-070, "In community water systems, water suppliers shall carry out a local cross connection program." The first step is to pass a "local ordinance or enabling authority."

The Board of Directors of the La Casa Mia Association Improvement District proposes that the following enabling authority be passed at the 1995 Annual Meeting:

**The La Casa Mia Association Improvement District is authorized to discontinue water service to premises for failure to install an approved backflow device or conduct a required annual test on a backflow device when deemed necessary by the Board of Directors.**

This ordinance was adopted at the annual meeting of the La Casa Mia Association Improvement District held on November 1, 1995.

The Board of Directors of the La Casa Mia Association needs all homeowners to complete the following survey and return it to PO Box 364, Redmond, OR 97756 by December 1st. This information gathering is part of a state-mandated program requiring all community water systems to have active cross connection control programs.

### Cross Connection Control Survey

Do you now have any of the following:

- Irrigation (using COI water)
- Swimming pool
- Hot tub/jacuzzi
- Active solar system
- Fire sprinkler system
- In-House antifreeze additive system
- Dark room
- Animal feed trough (using well water)
- Cistern

If you checked any of the above boxes, the La Casa Mia Association will make recommendations as to the type, if any, of Backflow Prevention Device needed.
