RE: Cross-connection Policy

Local management in coordination with DEQ, have determined that this cross connection plan is sufficient due to:

- The limited number of connections
- No private water treatment units are connected to the system
- The school building connected to the system poses no greater risk than a typical household connection.

This policy will be reviewed should conditions change with the public school, service connections, or the water treatment system

Description

- The Toketee Village drinking water system serves 16 connections and an estimated population of 30 people. The Toketee public school is no longer in operation.
- The water source for this system is surface water from Toketee Lake or Fish Creek.
- The treatment is a direct filtration unit, the U.S. Filter/Microfloc Tri Mite TM-100 is used and the treated water is stored in 2 tanks with a combined 8,000 gallon capacity.

Cross Connection Policy

- A back flow preventer will not be necessary on service connections to domestic housing.
- A back flow preventer will not be necessary on the service connection to the school building because it presents no higher risk of backflow than a domestic housing connection.

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
