RE: Reminder to monitor for disinfection byproducts at the City of Gold Hill public water system

Dear Mr. Bollweg,

Monitoring for disinfection byproducts must be conducted every year during the month of December at the City of Gold Hill because December was determined to be the month with the highest historical concentrations of disinfection byproducts. During the 2017 and 2018 calendar years; however, monitoring at the water system was conducted during the month of August instead of December, which constitutes a violation of Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 333-061-0036(4).

The City must therefore monitor disinfection byproducts during the month of December 2019 to address the violations from the previous year's monitoring. Please ensure this monitoring is conducted as specified in this letter and according to all the applicable provisions of OAR 333-061-0036(4) and report the results to the Authority no later than January 10, 2020.
