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RE: Notice of Non-Compliance regarding the Green Acres Mobile Home Park Public Water System, PWS OR4100523

Mr. Crawford:

Our records indicate that you own and operate the Green Acres Mobile Home Park (Park) water system located at 53752 Appleton Rd, Milton-Freewater, Oregon. Therefore, you are a water supplier as defined in Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 448.115(12) and Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 333-061-0020(207), and have specific responsibilities as defined in OAR 333-061-0025.

The Park is a community public water system, which serves approximately 200 people, and is subject to regulation under ORS 448.115 to 448.290 and OAR 333-061-0005 to 333-061-0272.

The Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Center for Health Protection, Drinking Water Services (DWS) has reviewed the operation of the Park water system. This review has found that you are not in compliance with the following Oregon administrative rules, and are therefore not meeting your responsibilities as a water supplier as prescribed by the Oregon Drinking Water Quality Act (ORS 448.115 to ORS 448.290) and rules.

DESCRIPTION OF RULE VIOLATIONS

• Violation No. 1: OAR 333-061-0076(6)(b) requires water systems using only groundwater sources to, within 120 days of written notification, correct any significant deficiencies identified during a sanitary survey, or to be in compliance with a corrective action plan. A sanitary survey was conducted on May 3, 2012 at the Park water system, and a letter was provided to you, on July 5, 2012 identifying significant deficiencies identified during the survey with a deadline of August 5, 2012 to submit a

corrective action plan. Furthermore, DWS has notified you by letter regarding the identified significant deficiencies on the following subsequent dates:

- February 27, 2014 requesting the Park submit an approved corrective action plan to DWS by March 27, 2014;
- September 29, 2014 requesting the Park submit an approved corrective action plan to DWS by October 29, 2014.

On October 28, 2014, DWS received an approved corrective action plan with a due date of March 1, 2015. As of this notice, DWS has received notice that all significant deficiencies identified in the May 2012 survey performed at the Park have been corrected with the exception of one deficiency. The failure to correct all the significant deficiencies by the approved date constitutes a violation of OAR 333-061-0076(6)(b).

ACTIONS REQUIRED TO ACHIEVE COMPLIANCE

Due to the rule violations identified above, you are required to complete the following actions relating to the Park water system:

• Compliance Action No. 1: You must correct the source significant deficiency identified in the letter dated August 5, 2012 relating to the sanitary survey conducted at the Park water system, and you must notify DWS when this compliance action is completed by **June 1, 2015.**

If you do not comply with the deadlines specified in this letter, the continued non-compliance may result in additional enforcement action including the assessment of civil penalties as prescribed by OAR 333-061-0090.
