RE: Reminder to monitor and report corrosion control water quality parameters for the City of Monroe public water system

Dear Mr. Bollweg,

Lead exceeded the action level in drinking water samples collected at the City of Monroe water system in the 2017 calendar year. The City was required to measure and report water quality parameters in the first and second halves of the 2018 calendar year after reviewing corrosion control treatment practices at its water treatment plant but the City did not report all the water quality parameters as required.

The City must therefore monitor or measure water quality parameters according to all the applicable provisions of OAR 333-061-0036(10)(f)(F) and during two consecutive sixmonth monitoring periods in the 2019 calendar year and report the results to OHA.

- The first round of monitoring must be completed prior to June 30, 2019; and
- The second round of monitoring must be completed six months after completing the first round.
