The Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Center for Health Protection, Drinking Water Services (DWS) regulates water systems and water suppliers. Our records indicate that you are representatives of Brewster Community Homeowners Association water system located and serving homes at Evanston and Niles Avenue NE, Salem, OR, and therefore Brewster Community Homeowners Association is a water supplier under Oregon law. Oregon Revised Statute 448.115(12) and Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 333-061-0020).

DWS sets the frequency for Community water systems at every three years. Your last survey was 2015 and therefore Brewster Community Homeowners Association must undergo a water system survey this year. OAR 33-061-0076(1). Marion County environmental public health staff have been delegated authority by DWS to do water system surveys. You have not responded to Marion County's request to set a date for the survey.

This letter is a written request for access to the entire water system to conduct a survey. You must Contact Greg DeBlase, Marion County, at (503) 588-5407. The survey must be completed by **June 25, 2018**.

If you do not contact Marion County and survey is not completed by June 25, 2018 you will be in violation of OAR 333-061-0076(2).
