RE: Extension to the Bilateral Compliance Agreement between the Oregon Health Authority and the City of Sandy

The City of Sandy entered into a bilateral compliance agreement (Agreement) with the Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Center for Health Protection, Drinking Water Services (DWS) on September 19, 2018 in order to ensure compliance at the City's public water system, identified by PWS ID# 4100789.

The agreement set forth actions to be completed by the City to ensure that all water delivered to users is treated for the parasite *Cryptosporidium*. Specifically, as part of this process, The City agreed to submit to DWS, no later than December 30, 2019, a revised master plan for the City's water system. The revised master plan is unable to be completed before this deadline due to circumstances beyond the City's control.


Based on the progress to satisfy the terms of the agreement, DWS agrees to an extension as specified below.

TERMS OF THE EXTENSION

- The City shall submit to DWS a revised master plan for the City of Sandy water system, no later than December 30, 2020.
- DWS and the City agree that this extension supersedes and replaces the corrective action identified in section III. A. in the Agreement that was effective between the parties on September 21, 2018 after being signed by DWS.


This extension only applies to the specific corrective action identified above, and it does not constitute a waiver, modification, or suspension of any other compliance actions, requirements, or information contained in the Agreement that was effective between the parties on September 21, 2018 after being signed by DWS, which remains in full force and effect.
