Bea Brown and Scooby Properties, LLC Pinewood Mobile Manor Public Water System BILATERAL COMPLIANCE AGREEMENT EXTENSION

Bea Brown and Scooby Properties, LLC (hereinafter "Water Supplier") entered into a bilateral compliance agreement (Agreement) with the Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Center for Health Protection, Drinking Water Services (DWS) on October 9, 2018 to ensure compliance at the Pinewood Mobile Manor water system (hereinafter "Water System"), identified by PWS ID# 4100872.

The Agreement set forth actions to be completed by Water Supplier to resolve the presence of nitrate above the maximum contaminant level at the Water System. Specifically, Water Supplier agreed to submit written verification to DWS of application for land use approval to deliver water to all users served by the Water System. The land use application; however, was not submitted to DWS within 60 days of signing the Agreement as specified therein due to circumstances beyond the control of Water Supplier.

Based on the progress to satisfy the terms of the Agreement, DWS agrees to an extension as specified herein.

TERMS OF THE EXTENSION

- Corrective Action No. 1: Water Supplier shall submit a copy of the application for land use approval to install a waterline for the delivery of water from well L128006 to all portions of the Water System no later than March 31, 2019.
- Corrective Action No. 2: Water Supplier shall notify DWS in writing within 5
 calendar days of receiving land use approval for installation of the waterline to deliver
 water from well L128006 to all portions of the Water System.
- Corrective Action No. 3: Water Supplier shall complete construction or installation of the waterline to deliver water from well L128006 to all portions of the Water System within three months of receiving land use approval for the project.
 - For this corrective action to be met, any construction or installation that was performed must meet the applicable construction standards in OAR 333-061-0050, as approved by DWS.
- Corrective Action No. 4: Water Supplier shall collect water samples according to OAR 333-061-0036(2)(c) and report testing results to DWS within thirty (30) calendar days of completing construction according to Corrective Action No. 3.
 - Water samples must show the drinking water delivered by the Water System is not above the MCL in OAR 333-061-0030(1) for nitrate.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

DWS and Water Supplier agree that this extension supersedes and replaces Corrective Actions No. 1 through No. 3 in the Agreement that was effective between the parties on October 9, 2019 after being signed by DWS.

This extension only applies to the specific corrective actions identified above, and it does not constitute a waiver, modification, or suspension of any other compliance actions, requirements, or information contained in the Agreement that was effective between the parties on October 9, 2019 after being signed by DWS, which remains in full force and effect.
