RE: Violation of the Notice of Non-Compliance issued on November 16, 2011 and possible civil penalties.

On November 16, 2011, the Oregon Health Authority, Office of Environmental Public Health, Drinking Water Program (Program) issued an Notice of Non-Compliance to you requiring corrective action be completed for the Rainier Park, LLC public water system.

Specifically, the Notice of Non-Compliance required that sampling results for synthetic and volatile organic chemicals be submitted to the Program no later than January 10, 2012. January 10, 2012 has passed without completion of the required action, and you are now at risk of being assessed civil penalties in the amount of \$50 for every distinct rule violation and for every day the Rainier Park, LLC water system is in violation of a rule (OAR 333-061-0090).


Furthermore, you have also failed to comply with the plan review requirements related to the new groundwater source providing water to the Rainier Park, LLC water system which is a violation of OAR 333-061-0060(1). You have also failed to designate an operator to be in direct responsible charge of the Rainier Park, LLC water system which is a violation of OAR 333-061-0225. Failure to immediately comply with either of these rules or the rules specified in the Notice of Non-Compliance issued on November 16, 2011 may result in the assessment of civil penalties as specified above.

If the Program intends to assess a civil penalty against you, you will be notified in writing and provided an opportunity for a hearing pursuant to the Oregon Administrative Procedures Act (ORS chapter 183).
