A water system survey was completed for Sunset Village MHP on 11/21/2018 identifying significant deficiencies and rule violations to be corrected. A letter and copy of the survey report were mailed on December 3, 2018. Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 333-061-0076(6) and OAR 333-061-0032(6)(e) requires water systems that use groundwater sources to have completed corrective action or be in compliance with a Department-approved corrective action plan within 120 days of receiving written notice of a significant deficiency.

Per an approved corrective action plan, Sunset Village MHP was to complete corrective action by 6/7/2019. To date, one of the deficiencies has not been corrected (Annual CCR not submitted). As a result, Sunset Village MHP is in violation and is now subject to formal enforcement which could include the assessment of civil penalties. In order to return to compliance and avoid formal enforcement action, the deficiency **must be corrected by 12/2/19**. Since Sunset Village MHP failed to take action within the required timeframe, you **must provide notification** to all persons served by the water system as soon as practical and by no later than 30 days after the date of this letter. The public notice must include the mandatory language and corrective action taken. You are also required to issue a repeat notice every three months until all deficiencies are corrected or you are in compliance with an approved corrective action plan. A copy of the Tier 2 public notice instructions and template are enclosed.

A copy of the public notice must be sent to the Oregon Health Authority - Drinking Water Program, PO Box 14350, Portland, OR 97293-0350 within ten (10) days after



completion to certify that Sunset Village MHP has fully complied with the distribution and public notification requirements.
