RE: Updated compliance schedule for violations at River Village MHP, PWS #4105854

Walt,

This letter is a follow-up to the previous compliance schedule set with Bill Goss. Per our conversations and conversations with the finance authority, the compliance schedule has been amended. These timelines are necessary as follow up to the violations the water system has been experiencing due to the arsenic detections.

River Village MHP water system has the following violation that must be resolved:

**Violation #1: Arsenic Maximum Contamination Level (MCL) exceedance.**

- 1) Plans for constructing a new production well must be submitted by August 1, 2018.
- 2) Construction of the new production well must be completed by December 31, 2018.
- 3) Drinking water that meets the arsenic MCL must be provided to customers by March 1, 2019.

We understand you have been working hard with the revolving loan fund agency and are waiting for the final items to be completed for the funds to be released.

Failure to comply with the above compliance schedule may result in formal enforcement action which could include the assessment of civil penalties. If you have any questions or concerns, please call me at 541-966-0901 or email at [amelia.a.word@state.or.us](mailto:amelia.a.word@state.or.us).
