Dear Mrs. Troyer:

Per **OAR 333-061-0025**, public water suppliers are responsible for taking action to assure the water delivered to water users does not exceed maximum contaminant levels. This is achieved by routinely collecting and submitting water samples for laboratory analyses at the frequencies prescribed by **OAR 333-061-0036**.

Saint John Bosco High School is currently in violation for not reporting required bacteriological and chemical water samples. Failure to meet monitoring requirements will lead to enforcement action from the Oregon Health Authority Drinking Water Program. To avoid being referred for enforcement action, the water system must begin routine monitoring by **May 1st, 2017**.

Total coliform bacteria monitoring is required quarterly. Your chemical monitoring schedule is included on a separate document. You will need to contact an accredited water testing lab and make arrangements to have the testing done. All test results need to be forwarded to the Oregon Health Authority Drinking Water Program at:
