RE: Total Coliform Monitoring and Reporting Requirements PWS #91168

Mr. Hood,

Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Drinking Water Services program records show that 'Aubrey-Watzek Cascade Pacific BSA' Public Water System did not meet monitoring and reporting requirements for Total Coliform bacteria during the 1st quarter monitoring period (Jan 01, 2015 – Mar 31, 2015) as required by OAR: 333-061-0036)(6)(b). As well, we noted that the water system also has not tested for Nitrates for 13 months:

Analyte	Minimum Sampling Frequency
Microbiological Contamination (coliform bacteria)	1 sample, each calendar quarter
	Sample in the distribution system
Nitrates	1 sample, each calendar year
	Sample at the 'Entry Point' to the distribution system

The first steps necessary to return to compliance are:

- 1. Immediately collect a water test sample for 'Total Coliform' from the distribution system and a water test sample for Nitrates from the 'Entry-Point'. Submit a copy of the results to the address shown below.
- 2. Check your testing records. If you have records of Total Coliform being sampled in the compliance period, submit a copy to the following address and be sure to include your PWS # on all water test results to ensure receiving credit for testing:
