RE: Microscopic Particulate Analysis at the Sunshine Plaza public water system.

Dear Mary Jacks,

The Oregon Health Authority, Drinking Water Services (DWS) determined the well serving your water system must be evaluated for influence by surface water because of the presence of total coliform bacteria and its proximity to Forest Creek. This evaluation is required by Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 333-061-0032(8). You must therefore collect at least two samples for microscopic particulate analysis as soon as possible, depending on weather conditions. The samples must be collected at least 30 days apart and only after periods of heavy rainfall or snowmelt.

If you do not complete the required sampling before the summer of 2017 you may be referred for further enforcement action, which could include the assessment of civil penalties according to OAR 333-061-0090.
