RE: Violation of the Administrative Order issued on April 19, 2011 and possible civil penalties.


On April 19, 2011, the Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Office of Environmental Public Health, Drinking Water Program (Program) issued an Administrative Order to you requiring corrective action to be completed at the Sawyer's Landing RV Park water system (PWS ID# OR4192061).

Specifically, the Administrative Order required that you submit complete construction plans to the Program no later than September 30, 2011, and that installation and construction of water treatment equipment be completed no later than December 31, 2011. A cartridge filtration unit was installed prior to the December 31 deadline, but plans and schematics identifying how this equipment was added to the Sawyer's Landing water system have not been submitted to the Program, which is a violation of OAR 333-061-0060. Failure to submit complete construction plans to the Program is a violation of the Administrative Order, and you are now at risk of being assessed civil penalties in the amount of \$50 for every distinct rule violation and for every day the Sawyer's Landing RV Park water system remains in violation of a rule (OAR 333-061-0090).

Furthermore, a sanitary survey was conducted on December 30, 2012 at the Sawyer's Landing RV Park water system and several significant deficiencies were identified in a letter dated January 31, 2012. OAR 333-061-0076(6)(a) requires that water systems correct deficiencies or respond with a corrective action plan within 45 days of being notified of significant deficiencies identified during a sanitary survey. More than 45 days have passed since January 31, 2012 and the Program has not received a response relating to the significant deficiencies identified in the January 31, 2012 letter, which is a violation of OAR 333-061-0076(6)(a).

In the event that the Program assesses a civil penalty against you, you will be notified in writing and provided an opportunity for a hearing pursuant to the Oregon Administrative Procedures Act (ORS chapter 183).
