RE: Warning letter for failing to conduct microscopic particulate analysis at the Smith River RV Park and Marina public water system

The Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Center for Health Protection, Drinking Water Services (DWS) has determined, according to OAR 333-061-0032(7), that the well supplying the Smith River RV Park and Marina water system (hereinafter "Water System") must be evaluated for the influence of surface water because of its proximity to surface water and the presence of coliform bacteria in sample results collected at the Water System.

You must therefore collect at least two samples for microscopic particulate analysis as soon as possible and when weather conditions are appropriate.

1. The first sample must be collected no later than May 30, 2019, after operations begin at the Water System for the 2019 season and after a period of heavy rainfall or snowmelt.
2. The second sample must be collected during an extended period of low rainfall and between August 1, 2019 and September 30, 2019.

If you do not complete the required sampling and report the results before October 31, 2019, the continued non-compliance may result in additional enforcement action and may include the assessment of civil penalties as prescribed by OAR 333-061-0090.
