RE: Failure to report nitrate monitoring results

The Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Center for Health Protection, Drinking Water Services (Authority) mailed a letter on October 12, 2016, notifying you nitrate monitoring was not reported for the Digit Point Campground water system (PWS ID# OR41-92830).

Specifically, the letter requested that nitrate monitoring for your water system be reported no later than January 10, 2017. This date has passed without completion of the required action, which constitutes a violation of Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 333-061-0036(2)(d) and is the second consecutive violation for failing to report annual nitrate monitoring.

You must immediately complete the monitoring as specified in OAR 333-061-0036(2)(d). Failure to complete the monitoring puts the Forest Service at risk of additional enforcement action, which could include the assessment of civil penalties in the amount of \$50 for every distinct rule violation and for every day the Digit Point Campground water system is in violation of a rule (OAR 333-061-0090).
