One of the deficiencies, lack of watertight sanitary seal and casing at the well, is considered a direct pathway for contamination to enter a water system and is a priority for correction.

The failure to correct the deficiencies by the original due date following the May 19, 2016 sanitary survey is a violation of Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 333-061-0076(6) if in fact, the deficiencies have not been corrected.

Please notify the Authority immediately if this deficiency or any other deficiencies have already been corrected. Otherwise, you must correct this deficiency within 30 days of the date of this notice and submit written verification of the date when the deficiency was corrected.
