RE: Violation of Administrative Order and possible civil penalties.

On April 20, 2020, the Oregon Health Authority, Drinking Water Services mailed a Notice of Violation and Administrative Order to you, requiring you to report nitrate monitoring for the Rogue Valley Stations public water system (ID# OR4193778).

You did not report the required monitoring by June 30, 2020 as specified in the Order and are now at risk of being assessed civil penalties in the amount of \$50 for every distinct rule violation, for every day (OAR 333-061-0090). To avoid being assessed civil penalties, you must immediately report nitrate monitoring for the Rogue Valley Stations public water system.

In the event Drinking Water services assesses a civil penalty against you, you will be notified in writing and provided an opportunity for a hearing pursuant to the Oregon Administrative Procedures Act (ORS chapter 183).
