RE: Notice of failure to correct significant deficiencies at the On The River Golf and RV Resort public water system

Records indicate that you, Richard Sumner, own and operate the public water system serving the On The River Golf and RV Resort (hereinafter "Water System"), located at 111 Whitson Lane in Myrtle Creek, Oregon. You (hereinafter "Water Supplier") are therefore a water supplier as defined in ORS 448.115(12) and OAR 333-061-0020(150) and have specific responsibilities as defined in OAR 333-061-0025.

The Water System is identified by public water system ID# OR4194929 and is subject to regulation according to the Oregon Drinking Water Quality Act (Oregon Revised Statutes 448.115 to 448.290) and Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 333-061-0005 through OAR 333-061-0272.

OAR 333-061-0076(5) requires water suppliers to correct significant deficiencies or to be in compliance with an approved corrective action schedule. The Oregon Health Authority, Drinking Water Services (DWS) has reviewed the operation of the Water System and found that significant deficiencies were identified during a sanitary survey conducted on October 25, 2021. Water Supplier has not reported that these significant deficiencies were corrected by the February 1, 2022 due date. Water Supplier is therefore not in compliance with OAR 333-061-0076(5) and not meeting its responsibilities as a water supplier.

One of the deficiencies, the lack of a flap valve, screen or equivalent protection for the overflow from a finished water storage facility, is considered a direct pathway for contamination to enter a water system and is a priority for correction.

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Please submit written verification to me that this deficiency is corrected within 30 days of the date of this notice.

If Water Supplier does not comply with the deadline specified in this letter, the continued non-compliance may result in additional enforcement action, which could include the assessment of civil penalties in the amount of \$50 for every distinct rule violation and for every day the Water System is in violation of a rule as prescribed by OAR 333-061-0090.
