Dear Sherman,

This letter is to inform you that coliform bacteria monitoring for your water system has not been reported since May 31, 2018.

This is a violation of Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 333-061-0036(6) if the monitoring was not conducted as required or a violation of OAR 333-061-0040(1) if the monitoring was conducted as required but not reported.

Due to the rule violations identified above, you must immediately monitor for coliform bacteria from the distribution system during the month of March 2019 in accordance with all the applicable requirements of OAR 333-061-0036(6). This monitoring must be reported to the Oregon Health Authority, Drinking Water Services by April 10, 2019 according to OAR 333-061-0040(1)(b)(A).
