RE: Failure to comply with administrative order and possible civil penalties.

On June 21, 2024, The Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Center for Health Protection, Drinking Water Services (DWS) issued a notice of violation and administrative order (Order) to you, Amritpreet Singh, (hereinafter “Water Supplier”) due to violations at the Super Speedy Plus public water system (hereinafter “Water System”), identified by PWS ID# OR4195141 and located at 80301 Territorial Hwy in Lorane, Oregon.

Specifically, the Order required monitoring for nitrate to be reported within 30 days and monitoring for coliform bacteria to be reported for six consecutive months. The date for reporting nitrate monitoring has passed without completion of the required action and without Water Supplier demonstrating progress toward completing the action. Additionally, Water Supplier only reported monitoring for coliform bacteria for one month.

Water Supplier is now at risk of being assessed civil penalties in the amount of \$100 for every distinct rule violation and for every day the Water System is in violation of a rule (OAR 333-061-0090).

In the event Drinking Water services assesses a civil penalty against Water Supplier, you will be notified in writing and provided an opportunity for a hearing pursuant to the Oregon Administrative Procedures Act (ORS chapter 183).



To avoid being assessed civil penalties, Water Supplier must immediately report both nitrate monitoring and resume reporting coliform monitoring every month and verify completing this action by sending an email to bradley.k.daniels@oha.oregon.gov.
