RE: Warning letter for failure to report coliform bacteria monitoring for the Lakeview Grocery public water system 4195160

Dear Cody,

This letter is to inform you that coliform bacteria monitoring for your water system has not been reported for the previous three sampling periods.

This is a violation of Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 333-061-0036(6) if the monitoring was not conducted as required or a violation of OAR 333-061-0040(1) if the monitoring was conducted as required but not reported.

Due to the rule violations identified above, you must monitor for coliform bacteria from the distribution system during the month of March 2019 in accordance with all the applicable provisions of OAR 333-061-0036(6). This monitoring must be reported to the Oregon Health Authority, Drinking Water Services by April 10, 2019 according to OAR 333-061-0040(1)(b)(A).
