This letter is to inform you that coliform bacteria monitoring for your water system has not been reported since January 18, 2018.

This is a violation of Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 333-061-0036(6) if the monitoring was not conducted as required or a violation of OAR 333-061-0040(1) if the monitoring was conducted as required but not reported.

Due to the rule violations identified above, you must immediately monitor for coliform bacteria according to your coliform sampling plan and all other applicable requirements of OAR 333-061-0036(6). This monitoring must be conducted in the month of April 2019 and reported to the Oregon Health Authority, Drinking Water Services by May 10, 2019 according to OAR 333-061-0040(1)(b)(A).
