ENABLING AUTHORITY
Public Water System ID# 41-00163
Rev. January 12, 2026

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this ordinance is to protect the health of the people served by this water system by preventing contaminants from flowing backwards into the water supply. To accomplish this, these rules are in compliance with Oregon Administrative Rules (OARs) 333-061-0070 through 333-0061-0074,

REQUIREMENTS:

Actual or potential cross connections are prohibited. If a potential exists for a cross-connection the water system must be protected by an appropriate backflow prevention device or assembly.

ENFORCEMENT:

The water system has the right to refuse or terminate water service to any customer who does not:

- Install a backflow device or assembly, when an actual or potential cross connection exists; and
- Test the assembly at least annually and complete necessary repairs.

The water system reserves the right to require a backflow device at the customer's side of the water meter if access is not allowed to determine if a back flow device or assembly is necessary.

The water system will allow a reasonable time to achieve compliance with our rules, but should a backflow incident occur, the water system has the right to terminate service immediately and restore it only after compliance.


ADDITIONAL:
