At a recent Board meeting, the Board of Directors of the Grand Ronde Community Water Ass'n. voted to have the entire water system protected with double-check valves on every service. To protect and maintain the high quality of our water, only State approved devices will be allowed. The devices will have to be installed at the point of delivery (directly behind the meter). If you currently have a device or are unsure please contact our office. The device can be purchased through the Water Ass'n. and installed by our personnel or you may purchase a device on your own and have a plumber of your choice install it. If you decide to do this work on your own, please contact our office when completed as all devices need to be registered with the Ass'n. Once installed the devices are to be tested once a year by a certified tester. All costs, including installation, inspection, testing and maintenance are the responsibility of the owner. A list of currently approved back-flow prevention devices and certified testers is available from our office as well as information on back-flow devices. The cost, if you decide to have the Water Ass'n. install a device is \$130.00 for a standard 3/4" service. This work must be completed by December 31, 1994.
