ORDINANCE NO. 65

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 62 ALLOWING THE CITY TO TERMINATE WATER SERVICE IF BACK-FLOW PREVENTION SYSTEMS ARE NOT INSTALLED AFTER NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNER AND DECLAIRING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Idanha ordains as follows:

1. Ordinance No. 62 is hereby amended by adding the following language to §37 of said Ordinance.

If the customer fails to install an approved back-flow prevention system after notice from the City, the City shall discontinue service as is provided in §37 of this Ordinance.

2. §37 of Ordinance No. 62 as amended shall read as follows:

Section 37. Back Siphonage. Customer shall not allow any water that has passed the service connection to flow back in to the system. The City may require the installation of an approved back-flow prevention system. When, in the discretion of the Water Department such a device is required, it shall be installed in accordance with all applicable federal, state and local laws, regulations, and ordinances in effect at the time of installation. After installation, the back-flow prevention device shall be inspected by a State of Oregon licensed back-flow device inspector. A copy of the certificate of inspection shall be furnished to the City. Customer shall be liable for all costs of back-flow prevention device installation, maintenance and inspection. If the customer fails to install an approved back-flow prevention system after notice from the City, the City shall discontinue service as is provided in §32 of this Ordinance.
