RESOLUTION

REVISED CROSS-CONNECTION CONTROL PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Mulino Water District No. 23 has determined that the District's Cross-Connection Program be revised and updated as mandated by the Oregon State Health Division, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this resolution is to protect the health and safety of the users of the District in controlling and eliminating cross connections within the public water system, and

WHEREAS, no water service connection shall be installed or maintained by the District unless the water supply is protected as required by OAR 333-61-0070 and in conformance of the District's Rules and Regulations, and

WHEREAS, the installation and maintenance of any required backflow prevention assembly shall be at the expense of the user(s), and


WHEREAS, service of water to any premise shall be discontinued by the District if a backflow prevention assembly required is not installed, tested, maintained, removed, bypassed or an unprotected cross-connection exists, and


WHEREAS, a approved double check valve assembly shall be required for irrigation systems as minimum backflow protection. Well(s) shall be considered an auxiliary water supply and subject to a reduced pressure backflow prevention device at the service connection unless the pump and motor are removed, a cap welded in place on the wellhead, and one full length of pipe (twenty feet) is removed immediately down stream of the wellhead, and


WHEREAS, the user or owner of the premises where one or more backflow prevention devices are installed shall cause a test to be preformed at the time of installation and at a minimum of once a year by a certified state tester, and


WHEREAS, any violations of the backflow prevention program shall be cause for immediate termination of service until such time that violations are corrected.


BE IT RESOLVED that the Cross-Connection Control program is hereby revised and adopted this 3rd day of December, 2002.
