We are pleased to provide you with this year's Annual Quality Drinking Water Report. We want to keep you informed about the excellent water services we have delivered to you over the past year. Our goal is and always has been to provide you a safe and dependable supply of drinking water.

We received our Source Water Assessment Report this year from Clackamas County Environmental Health Department –Drinking water Program.

The 1996 Amendments to the Safe drinking Water Act required that all states conduct Source Water Assessments for public water systems within their boundaries. The purpose of the assessment is to provide water systems with the information they need to develop a strategy to protect their drinking water if they choose. The respective drinking water program of the Department of Human Services and Environmental Quality have completed the assessment for our system. A copy of the report is on file at the water systems office.

Excalibur Village drinking water is monitored monthly and extensive tests are taken once yearly according to federal and state laws. The results of the monitoring for the period of 2012 shows that we have no reportable contaminates. Test results are on file at the manager's office. Tenants may view them upon request of the office manager.
