BY LAWS

LIABILITY OF LEAKAGE ON PREMISES

All water leakage occurring between the Districts service connection and the customer's service line in or on the premises are the responsibility of the customer. The customer shall be responsible for the proper repair of such leaks. Leaks in customers lines shall be repaired as soon as detected.

The District shall not be liable for any damage or injury whatsoever for leakage or the running of water on the premises from pipe lines, plumbing fixtures, open faucets, valves, fixtures, devices, appurtenances, and hoses beyond the service connections.

TURNING ON OR OFF WATER SERVICE

Unless authorized by the District, no person other than an employee, or representative of the District, shall turn any service on, or off.

Customer desiring either discontinuance of service, a new service, or restoration of service, shall arrange for such services with the District.

CROSS CONNECTIONS

Neither cross connections, nor physical connections of any kind shall be made to any other water supply, whether public or private, without consent and approval of the Board and the written consent and approval of the State of Oregon's Department of Human Resources, Health Division.

When approved, all cross connections or physical connections with other water supplies or systems shall be made in strict accordance with requirements and recommendations of the State of Oregon's Department of Human Resources, Health Division.

TEMPORARY SERVICE

Application must be made to the District for temporary service connection.

Customer shall pay in advance for the labor, construction costs, and materials for such service connections.

Customer shall pay for water usage in accordance with the established rate schedule.
