VISTA HOME PARK WATER ORDINANCE

The purpose of this ordinance is to protect the water supply of Vista Home Park from contamination or pollution from any cross connections; and to assure that approved backflow prevention assemblies are tested when put into service and at least on an annual basis thereafter. This ordinance is in compliance with Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 333-061-0071 and the Uniform Plumbing Code (UPC) as adopted by the State of Oregon.

The installation or maintenance of any unprotected cross connection which would endanger the water supply of Vista Home Park is prohibited. Any such cross connection now existing or hereafter installed is hereby declared unlawful and shall be immediately protected or eliminated. This includes customer lines leading to lawn, garden or fire sprinkling systems using the water supply from Vista Home Park's distribution system.

The control or elimination of cross connection and the criteria from determining degrees of hazard and prescribing appropriate levels of protection shall be in accordance with the UPC and or OAR's.

Water service to any premise shall be contingent upon the customer providing appropriate cross connection control if determined necessary. Water service may be refused or terminated to any premises where an unprotected cross connection may allow contamination or pollutants to backflow into Vista Park's drinking water system.

Authorized employees of Vista Park shall have the right to enter upon and inspect any water plumbing system receiving water from Vista Home Park for conducting hazard assessment surveys. Water service may be refused or terminated, or maximum backflow protection may be required, to the premise where access to perform surveys is denied, where unprotected cross connections are located, or in the event that installed assemblies are not tested and maintained as required by State and local regulations.

If a violation of this ordinance exists and if after notification the violation is not rectified within 30 days, Vista Home Park reserves the right to discontinue all water service to the premises without further notice. However, in the event of an actual backflow incident which endangers the public health, water service may be terminated immediately and not restored until the cross connection is either eliminated or adequately protected.

This ordinance is adopted this 20th day of November 2010 by the owners of Vista Home park.
