

# Enabling Authority for Small Water Systems

This policy is intended to protect the health of the people served by this water system by preventing contaminants from flowing backwards into the water supply. Compliance with OAR 333-061-0070 through -0074 will be accomplished by the following rules.

Actual or potential cross connections are prohibited. If a potential exists for a cross connection the water system must be protected by an appropriate backflow prevention device.

Deer Trail Water has the right to refuse or terminate water service to any member who does not install a backflow device or assembly when required, including at least annual testing and any necessary repairs.

Deer Trail Water reserves the right to demand a backflow device at the member's side of the water meter if access is not allowed to determine if a backflow device is necessary.

Deer Trail Water will allow reasonable time to comply with our rules. However, should a backflow incident occur Deer Trail Water has the right to immediately terminate service and only restore service following compliance.
