TO: All Dayton Avenue Water Line Members

The State of Oregon through its Department of Human Resources has required that all organizations supplying water, such as our Water Line, pass a Resolution complying with the requirements of the "Safe Drinking Water Act," a Federal Law, and the Oregon Administrative Rules Chapter 330.

Basically, this means that the Water Line must conduct periodic cross-connection inspections of the water systems on the premises of its members. Cross-connections consist of some manner of pollution or possible contamination from a source other than the water supplied by the Water Line. At present, we are now required to conduct annual inspections of all connections.

In order to comply with the State of Oregon's directive, the Dayton Avenue Water Line Board of Directors has enacted the enclosed Resolution. If you have any questions pertaining to this matter, please contact Ron Wright, President of the Water Line, or Monte Glud, Vice President of the Water Line

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DAYTON AVENUE WATER LINE PROVIDING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CONTROLLING AND ELIMINATING CROSS-CONNECTIONS AND PREVENTING AND ELIMINATING CONTAMINATIONS OR POLLUTION OF THE WATER SUPPLY AS DIRECTED BY THE STATE OF OREGON, OAR 330


SECTION 1. POTENTIAL CONTAMINATION OF DAYTON AVENUE WATER LINE WATER SUPPLY: It is unlawful for any member of the Dayton Avenue Water Line, hereinafter shown as the "Water Line," or user of water supplied by the Water Line, to introduce or permit the introduction of pollution or contamination of any kind from any system or device such as a well, or sprinkling system, into the Water Line supply system. Whenever cross-connection to other water supply into the Water Line is found, or presents the possibility of contamination or pollution, the water supply to such premises and/or other premises from which cross-connection is made, shall be discontinued immediately until the cross-connection is eliminated or the condition remedied. Control or elimination of cross-connection shall be in accordance with any manuals of standard practice pertaining to cross-connection approved by the Board of Directors of the Water Line or its representative, and any requirement set forth by the "Safe Drinking Water Act," Public Law 93-523, and subsequent applicable legislation by the State of Oregon, such as OAR 330, etc.

SECTION 2. INSPECTION OF PREMISES SERVED BY THE WATER LINE: It shall be the responsibility of any and all members of the Water Line or persons residing on the premises served by the Water Line, to allow officials of the Water Line or its authorized representative access to the premises to inspect as necessary for cross-connections as required by the "Safe Drinking Water Act," Public Law 93-523, and applicable legislation by the State of Oregon, such as OAR 330.

SECTION 3. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE WATER LINE'S RESOLUTION CONCERNING CONTROL AND ELIMINATION OF CROSS-CONNECTION AND PREVENTION AND ELIMINATION OF CONTAMINANTS OR POLLUTION OF THE WATER SUPPLY: Failure to comply with this resolution will cause the immediate discontinuance of water supply by the Water Line. This resolution is to take effect immediately upon its approval by the Board of Directors of the Dayton Avenue Water Line.
