Re: S-Curves Water Main Project (PR#162-2018) City of Cannon Beach (PWS ID#00164) Conditional Approval

Dear Mr. Ayers:

Thank you for your submittal to the Oregon Health Authority's Drinking Water Services (DWS) of plan review information for the S-Curves Water Main project for City of Cannon Beach. On December 11, 2018, our office received a set of plans, specifications, land use compatibility statement and a plan review fee of \$3,300.

The project includes installation of 8" waterline and associated appurtenances in S. Hemlock Street in Cannon Beach.

The plans are approved with the following conditions:

- All items in contact with potable water must meet NSF Standard 61.
- The design must allow for 20 psi to be maintained at all service meters.
- Disinfection of the waterline must be completed according to AWWA C651.
- Parallel separations must conform to OAR 333-061-0050(9). Note that any zone conflicts represented in Figure 1 in that rule other than zone 1 conflicts must be approved by OHA/DWS.

Until we receive verification that the conditions have been met and final approval has been issued, the facility is not approved for use. Upon completion of the project, the engineer must verify in writing that construction was completed according to the submitted plans. If substantial changes are made, a set of as-built drawings must be submitted.
