Dear Laura:

Thank you for your submittal to the Oregon Health Authority's Drinking Water Services (DWS) of plan review information for the Shasta 975 Reservoir Upgrade Project for Eugene Water & Electric Board. On March 16, 2023, our office received plans and specifications and on March 21, 2023, a plan review fee of \$3300.

The project includes demolishing the existing 1.75 MG welded steel reservoir (Shasta 975) and constructing two 0.5 MG glass-coated, bolted steel reservoirs on a concrete slab foundation at the same site.

The plans are approved with the following conditions:


- Disinfection of the reservoir prior to use must be accomplished according to AWWA Standard C652.

Until we receive verification that the conditions have been met and final approval has been issued, the reservoirs are not approved for use. Upon completion of the project, the engineer must verify in writing that construction was completed according to the submitted plans. If substantial changes are made, a set of as-built drawings must be submitted. Documentation demonstrating how the above conditions were met should reference Plan Review #30-2023 and can be emailed to me at keith.male@oha.oregon.gov.
