Thank you for your submittal to the Oregon Health Authority's Drinking Water Services (DWS) of plan review information for the Odyssey Hills Waterlines for Sunrise Water Authority. On September 18, 2025, our office received a Notice of Decision for Type II Land Use, water plans, and a plan review fee of \$3,300.

The project includes the installation of AWWA C151 ductile iron waterlines in the Odyssey Hills proposed residential development.

The plans are approved subject to the following conditions:

• The design must allow for 20 psi to be maintained at all service meters

Until we receive verification that the conditions have been met and final approval has been issued, the waterlines are not approved for use. Upon completion of the project, the engineer must verify in writing that construction was completed according to the submitted plans. If substantial changes are made, a set of as-built drawings must be submitted.
