Re: Bornstedt Views Subdivision Waterlines (PR#52-2024) City of Sandy – WS #00789) Conditional Approval

Dear Ray:

Thank you for your submittal to the Oregon Health Authority's Drinking Water Services (DWS) of plan review information for the Bornstedt Views Subdivision waterlines project for the City of Sandy. On April 10, 2024, our office received plans, a land use compatibility statement, a land use proposal, and a plan review fee of \$3,300.

The project includes the installation of 8" AWWA C-151 ductile iron, cement lined and bitumastic coated waterlines in the Bornstedt Views Subdivision. This is a new subdivision in the City of Sandy.

The plans are approved with the following conditions:

- Air-relief valves, if needed, must be installed at high points where air can accumulate. The breather tube on air-relief valves must be extended above ground surface and provided with a screened, downward facing elbow.
- After disinfection of the waterlines is completed according to AWWA C651, results from the coliform sampling must be provided to OHA/DWS.

Until we receive verification that the conditions have been met and final approval has been issued, the waterlines are not approved for use. Upon completion of the project, the engineer must verify in writing that construction was completed according to the submitted plans. If substantial changes are made, a set of as-built drawings must be submitted. Documentation demonstrating how the above conditions were met should reference Plan Review #52-2024 and can be emailed to me at keith.male@oha.oregon.gov.
