Re: **Concrete Finished Water Storage Tank (2 MGal)** City of Scappoose – WS # 00792 Conditional Approval – PR # 57-2024

Mr. Stockton:

Thank you for your submittal to the Oregon Health Authority's Drinking Water Services (DWS) of plans of building the concrete two-million-gallon storage tank for City of Scappoose. On 23 April 2024, our office received plans and specifications for the storage tank, a geotechnical report on the site, and a plan review fee payment.

The plans are approved with the following conditions {unless otherwise noted, rule references are from <u>OAR 333-061-0050...</u> }:

• Concrete was sufficiently reinforced

(6)(a)(D)

- The outlet end of the drain/overflow must be fitted with angle-flap valve or equivalent protection and must discharge with an airgap to a watercourse or storm drain capable of accommodating the flow (6)(a)(M)
- Ground-level reservoirs that are located partially below ground must have footing drains discharging to daylight to carry away ground water which may accumulate around the perimeter of the structure (6)(a)(G)

A silt stop must be provided at the outlet pipe

(6)(a)(N)

Facilities properly disinfected using AWWA C652

(10)(e)

All items in contact with potable water must meet NSF Standard 61

333-061-0087(5)

I also have the following comments:

- Consider performing a tracer study on the tank once completed (6)(a)(R)
- If none already exists install a flow meter on the tank once completed (6)(a)(S)

Until we receive verification that the conditions have been met and final approval has been issued, the storage tank is not approved for use. Upon any more modifications to the project, the engineer must verify in writing that construction was completed according to the submitted plans. If substantial changes are made, a set of as-built drawings must be submitted.
