## Re: Hammond Waterline (PR#170-2019) City of Warrenton (PWS ID#00932) Conditional Approval

Dear Mr. Stelzig:

Thank you for your submittal to the Oregon Health Authority's Drinking Water Services (DWS) of plan review information for the Hammond waterline project for the City of Warrenton. On November 13, 2019, our office received a set of plans. A plan review fee of \$3,300 was received on November 7, 2019.

The project includes installation of an 18" C905 waterline and associated appurtenances.

The plans are approved with the following conditions:

- All items in contact with potable water must meet NSF Standard 61.
- The design must allow for 20 psi to be maintained at all service meters.
- The distance between tracer wire lead access locations must not be more than 1,000 feet.
- Results from the post-disinfection coliform sampling must be provided to our office.
- Any sewer and water line crossings must conform to OAR 333-061-0050(9). Parallel separations must also conform to this rule. Note that any zone conflicts represented in Figure 1 in that rule other than zone 1 conflicts must be approved by OHA/DWS.

Until we receive verification that the conditions have been met and final approval has been issued, the facility is not approved for use. Upon completion of the project, the engineer must verify in writing that construction was completed according to the submitted plans. If substantial changes are made, a set of as-built drawings must be submitted.
