Dear Mr. Brown:

Thank you for your submittal of plans for the Minor Modifications to the 42,000 Gallon Finished Water Reservoir at the Midland Water Association. The Drinking Water Program (DWP) received a copy of the plan submittal from Micah Olson, who is copied on this correspondence. A waiver from the plan review fee has been approved, as the project consists of minor modifications to an existing water system facility. The project includes constructing a new steel watertight roof, with a screened vent, and a screened outlet on the overflow pipe. The project is approved with the following conditions:

• The curbed roof hatched entry to the reservoir must be lockable, as required by Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 333-061-0050 (6)(a)(J).

Upon completion of the project, Midland must verify that construction was completed according to the submitted plans, and that all conditions of the approval listed above have been addressed. If substantial changes are made, a set of 'as-built' drawings must be submitted.
